Why Barbara? Gibraltar's famous Barbary Apes, of which there are around 230, are actually a species of tailless monkeys; *Macaca Sylvanus*. They roam freely around the Upper Rock and are looked after by the Gibraltar Ornithological & Natural History Society. No one is actually sure how they got to Gibraltar, however, speculation has it they were brought either by the Arabs sometime after 711CE or the British after 1704.
