Why Molly? Molly Bloom is a fictional character in the novel Ulysses by James Joyce (1st published February 1922). Molly, whose given name is Marion, was born in Gibraltar in 1870, the daughter of Major Tweedy, an Irish military officer, and Lunita Laredo, a Gibraltarian of Spanish Jewish descent. You can find a statue of Molly in the Alameda Gardens next to the Cable Car base station. Joyce fans now celebrate 16 June as Bloomsday.
